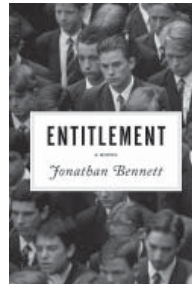

Entitlement

Andy Kronk had been twisted up in the Aspinall financial and political dynasty for decades before he got away. When he finally did manage to successfully leave, it turned out, a few months later, that the attempt was much less successful than he at first thought, as the drama of his former life finds its way back into his lap. Eventually he finds himself talking to a writer who is set on creating a profile work on the Aspinall family, and that allowed the door for the real mistakes to open.



Written in a style that sweeps you along and leaves you extremely satisfied, *Entitlement* is quite the accomplishment by Bennett. Fast-paced and packed with poignant plot, it is the type of read that keeps you on the edge of your seat, as if you were watching a thriller film.
