Lonely Planet knows not everyone has a travel budget that encompasses five-star hotels, Michelin three-star meals, and a car and driver to get you around. For those looking to maximize their experience for minimum money, the Shoestring guides are a godsend. Each book covers multiple countries (so you don't need to buy more than one guide for the trip), accommodations for budget traveling, sights to take in that cost little or no money, and more low-cost food options than you'll be able to work your way through. The usual high quality Lonely Planet maps and summaries are included, short but helpful language, transportation, and health chapters and commentary on the countries, cities, and location throughout. A useful guide for students looking at spending the summer backpacking around without having to sleep under a hedge to save money.
