Falling Off the Edge

Putting himself directly into the line of fire, straight into the frying pan and the fire at the same time, Perry relates his first hand experience of the devastating effects of globalization, and does so with riveting detail that makes you think twice before doing what you do. He makes you think twice about buying that item that was “Made in China,” he makes you think twice about the western world’s meddling in every corner and crevice into the country, he makes you think twice about the homogenizing of the planet that is occurring.
