property Kenny's family owns, and Kenny immediately—and fearlessly—sets out to get to know this dragon. The story that follows is humorous and endearing, and gets the heart of

what friendship is really all about. This was a fun book to read—the author is very good at moving the story along so that it flows. One of the things I liked best about the story is that it makes the point that preconceived ideas about others are generally not the best to go with.
