## **Klutz Build a Book: A Book That's All About My Family**

In this DIY book-making kit for kids, there is enough stuff to keep any child busy for a couple of hours. The heart of the kit is a wire-bound book with pages to fill with your own information, pictures, art, and words. Klutz provides suggestions and instructions on pages meant to be torn out, leaving just the pages you do yourself. To make your pages more interesting, there are colorful papers to use as backgrounds or borders, foam shapes and letters to glue onto the pages (glue stick also included); even googly eyes to add for added fun. And, this is the sort of project that pays off twice. First, when it's used to keep an child busy for hours and, second, when it's given as a gift to family member that lives far away. Easy to do, fun, and potentially cherishable for years to come.
