Lexi awakens in a forest, dirty, disheveled and scratched up, and has no idea who or where she is. She wanders out of the forest, following a bird that seems to be leading the way, and discovers a town nearby. She is led to a shelter where she is provided with warmth, safety and necessities, and then sets out to discover who she is and where she belongs. In the process she meets some delightful – and not

so great – characters along the way. I enjoyed reading this book, and was particularly impressed by the authors' imaginative attention to detail, which really pulls the reader into the story. I recom-
