## **Moon Flights**

*Night Shade Books, 24.95, 276 pages*

This collection of short fiction by Nebula Award-winning author Elizabeth Moon is at times serious and funny. The publisher has done well in alternating the humorous and serious stories, allowing the reader to never feel fully depressed not overly lighthearted. Moon writes military SF primarily, and this collection showcases that. But, she also wrote many funny stories for the *Chicks in Chainmail* series, with an equal amount of the same talent that garnered her high awards in the SF community. *Moon Flights* is a great introduction to Moon's work. No story fails to entertain. Pay particular attention to "New World Symphony" and "Say Cheese," a previously unpublished story.
