My Style Studio

For the budding fashionista, Klutz has created a style studio to design your own fashions. First, you create the model you want to design around, and then you use tracing paper to draw your clothes over the model. Color pencils, a sharpener, a black marker, tracing paper, and an eraser are all included. The instruction book explains different fashion concepts, use of color, clothing designs and patterns. The only weak point in the book is the limited amount of tracing paper—only 50 sheets are in the set. While tracing paper is easy enough to get, there will be a small amount of set up to adjusting it for this kit. One nice point is that *My Style Studio* isn't a licensed product, children will be designing clothes for their own creations, not Barbie or Bratz.
