The Treasury of American Prayers

By James P. Moore Jr.

Doubleday, \$27.95, 354 pages

This book is a compilation of prayers of early American History. There are prayers on Faith and Trust, and Thanksgiving and Appreciation, and even the prayer of California. It includes hundreds of prayers, as well as brief history as to where the prayer was originated. It is not geared towards any specific religion and includes Christian, Jewish, and Muslim prayers. Born and raised Catholic, as well as attending Catholic schools for 13 years, I have a certain appreciation for praying. Often times, I do not know exactly what to say, but this book is a great tool for those tongue-tied moments.
