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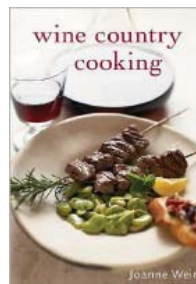

Wine Country Cooking

Joanne Weir is a James Beard award-winning cookbook author. She has a cooking program on PBS and does cooking tours in France and Italy, and now has a new cookbook focusing on the ingredients found in the California Napa-Sonoma wine country. *Wine Country Cooking* has the recipes from her 1999 *Weir Cooking: Recipes From the Wine Country*, but also includes fifty new recipes, cooking tips, and highly useful wine pairings for each dish. The dishes focus on fresh ingredients, Mediterranean flavors, and mostly easy to follow recipes. In today's trend of five-ingredient, 30-minute-or-



less cookbooks, *Wine Country Cooking* is swimming upstream, but the end result is well worth your time and energy. Easily a book you will pull out, mark up, and use repeatedly, especially this summer when the farmer's markets burst with fresh tomatoes, peppers, herbs, and more.
